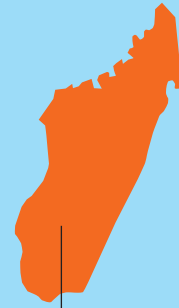




UNICEF PROJECT CLIMATE SMART VILLAGES IN MADAGASCAR

An integrated approach to making the living environment of children

PROBLEM



Madagascar is one of the poorest countries in the world



42% of children under the age of 5 are malnourished



Madagascar is severely affected by climate change



In the south, extreme drought prevails, causing crop failures



This threatens the living environment and development of children

SOLUTION

Reduce the impact of climate change on children



Making 20 villages in the south of Madagascar 'climate-smart'



Each village will have access to clean water



Each village will have eco-toilets



Install sustainable facilities for (solar) energy and internet



Increase knowledge about climate change

RESULTS

Partly due to the support from **UNICEF Business Buddies** we have already achieved a



30.000 jerrycans filled with water have been sold



75 community meetings were organized to increase knowledge about climate change and strengthen social cohesion



21 villages have been made climate-smart



1,330 sustainable products were developed and 800 products were sold
