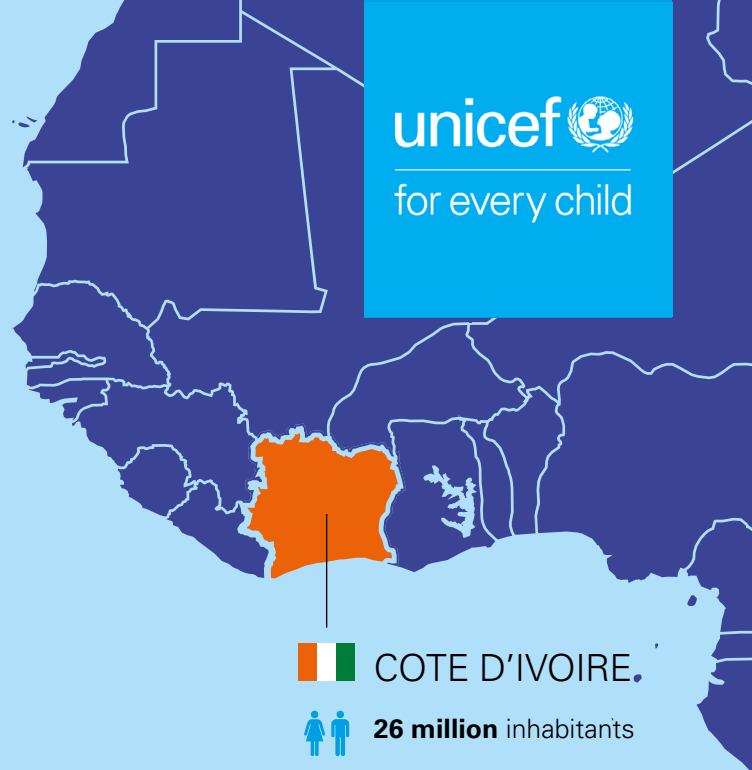

 COTE D'IVOIRE.

 **26 million** inhabitants


 **13 million** children under the age of 18

SITUATION

1 **288.000 kilo** plastic waste per day in a city like Abidjan
Only **5%** is recycled


2  Many chances of diseases due to waste problem

3  Many families live in poverty

4  Significant shortage of classrooms
1,5 million children do not receive an education

SOLUTION

UNICEF and partners have established a sustainable chain where plastic is recycled into building blocks for classrooms


Less environmental pollution

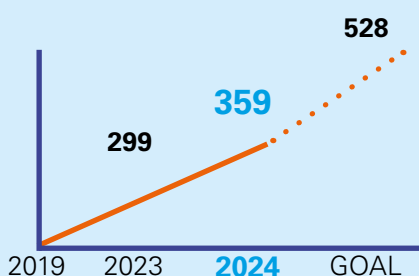

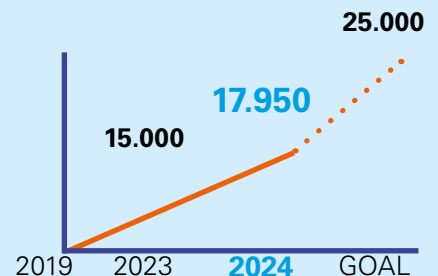
